



In the bottom of the first Bob Arndt threw a runner out at first base from his position in short centerfield. It was a very strong throw! The End Zone scored 1 more in the top of the second and in the bottom SS Rob Gruba threw a SKB runner out at home to preserve a 2-1 lead. A Bob Moore double followed by a pair of walks, A Chris Lehman triple and a Frans Haumersen single put the End Zone ahead 6-1 after 2 1/2. In the bottom of the 3rd there was a long single off the fence followed by a walk and a 2 run double by Frank Golad to cut the lead to 6-3 after 3.
