

Bronze Division
Englewood Men's Senior Softball League Rules - 2019

1. The Bronze Division will follow the rules adopted for the Gold Division with the following exceptions or modifications.
2. Rules 2 (1) and (7) - Pitcher Safety shall be modified to read:
 - 1) A pitching screen is mandatory for all games and pitchers are encouraged to wear a mask and other protective equipment.
 - 7) Prior to issuing an official warning to the pitcher, the umpire will issue a soft warning by advising the catcher that the pitcher is not moving behind the screen and is about to get an official warning. The catcher will be permitted to visit the pitching mound to advise the pitcher.
3. Each team will have a roster consisting of a minimum of 14 players.
4. There will be no player pool. If teams are short of 11 players, they may borrow a player from the other team, secure a player from the Silver Division Primary Pool, or recruit any player at the park who is registered as a Silver Division player.
5. Bases will be set at 60 feet.
6. A chalk line will be used as the pitching rubber. A chalk line will also be used instead of a second home plate for scoring.
7. Teams will be allowed an unlimited number of courtesy runners from home plate. The courtesy runner may not advance past first base. A line will be drawn from the pitcher's rubber through the point on the home plate to the backstop. The courtesy runner must start behind that line.
8. A player may be a courtesy runner from home plate or on the bases more than once during an inning. If a player is on base as a courtesy runner when it is his turn to bat, he will be replaced by another courtesy runner and no out will be recorded.
9. As with other divisions, the batter will start with a 1-1 count and there will be a courtesy foul with two strikes.
