

Previous week's scores are broadcast on WENG radio every Monday morning at ~7:20

Week 7 of the Englewood Men's Senior Softball league is in the books and with just 8 games left in the regular season the race for first remains tight in all three divisions, with some head-to-head match ups yet to be played between the first and second place teams. Let's get to the scores from last week.

In Tuesday's Bronze division games, the Elders beat the Relics 20 to 18 while the Classics edged the Legends in a tight one, 8 to 7.

Over in the Silver division, Porter Contracting edged Xpertech Auto Repair 15 to 14; Caddy Carts rolled over Designer Tee's 28 to 7; Arturs Restaurant beat Grumpy's Hot Dogs 27 to 20 while Warrior Homes topped Libee's Sports Bar 16 to 5.

In Thursday's Bronze games the Elders beat the Relics 20 to 18 while the Classics edged the Legends 8 to 7.

Thursday's Silver games saw Caddy Carts, with a 28 to 17 win over Porter Contracting, pull in to a tie for first with Xpertech Auto Repair as Xpertech was edged by Warrior Homes 14 to 13. In the other games, Grumpy's Hot Dogs topped Libee's Sports Bar 15 to 14 while Arturs Restaurant beat Designer Tee's 17 to 14.

On Wednesday in the Gold division, New Faull Inn edged the Hitmen 15 to 13 in a showdown between first place teams, the Sun Kings continued their winning ways beating the End Zone Sports Bar 18 to 15; the Shipwreck Pub squeaked by the Englewood Moose lodge 15 to 14 despite a homerun from Mike Vaught, his fifth of the season. In the fourth game, Ken & Barb's Restaurant cooked Key Agency 12 to 2.

In Friday's Gold games the Sun Kings beat the Shipwreck Pub 15 to 12 despite a homerun from Todd Widrick, his 10th of the year. New Faull Inn beat the End Zone Sports Bar 19 to 17; the Hitmen edged Ken and Barb's Restaurant 16 to 15 while the Englewood Moose Lodge beat Key Agency 14 to 10 behind a grand slam homerun from Brian Donehue.

The league now moves in to the last third of the schedule this week with tight races in all divisions. The Elders hold a slim 1 game lead over the Relics in the Bronze division; Caddy Carts and Xpertech are tied for first at 10 wins, 4 losses, and New Faull Inn holds a slim lead over the Hitmen and the Sun Kings with each of those teams playing the other at least once in the next three weeks. Expect some movement in all three division standings as these teams have been playing very good ball in the last two weeks.

So, there's never been a better time to come on out and join the many fans that are cheering their teams on. The weather is good, the play is terrific and even the umpires are getting a few cheers now and then. Games are played Tuesday thru Friday on the adult softball fields at the Englewood Sports Complex, just down the road from the radio station at 1300 River Road, starting at 9:30 with the second games starting at 11.
