

Previous week's scores are broadcast on WENG radio every Monday morning at ~7:20

Week 8 of the Englewood Senior Softball league was filled with homeruns and close games in all divisions and the race for the division championships remain tight.

Let's get right to the scores.

On Tuesday in the Bronze division, the Elders edged the Classic 19 to 18 while the Relics beat the Legends 20 to 19.

On Tuesday in the Silver division over on fields 1 and 2, Warrior Homes topped Porter Contracting 20 to 14; Grumpy's Hot Dogs doubled up Designer Tee's 16 to 8; Artur's Restaurant served Xpertech Auto Repair with a 21 to 15 loss while the game between Caddy Carts and Libee's Sports Bar was postponed due to a game related delay.

In Wednesday's Gold division games it was close scores all around as Ken & Barb's Restaurant edged the Sun Kings 18 to 17; New Faull Inn, behind a home run from Larry Tarn, edged the Englewood Moose Lodge 19 to 18 despite a furious 7th inning comeback attempt by the Moose. The Hitmen edged Key Agency 16 to 15 and the Shipwreck Pub fell to the End Zone Sports Bar 19 to 16 behind a grand slam home run from Bob Moore.

Thursday's games in the Bronze division saw the Classics top the Elders 16 to 12 with Barry Griffin of the Classics hitting his 8th home run for the year while Jerry Barthol hit a dinger for the Elders. In the other game, the Relics beat the Legends 17 to 12 with Don Myhrberg (Meer-burg) of the Relics and Al Lee each hitting homeruns for their teams.

Likewise on Thursday in the Silver division, Xpertech Auto Repair edged Designer Tee's 11 to 10 while Warrior Homes topped Caddy Carts 22 to 15. With those wins, Xpertech and Warrior Homes moved in to a tie for first place, with Caddy Carts sitting one game out with Tuesday's postponed game yet to be played. In the other games, Grumpy's Hot Dogs edged Porter Contracting 11 to 10 while Libee's Sports bar beat Artur's Restaurant 18 to 15.

In Friday's Gold Division games, the Hitmen moved into a tie for first with a 14 to 8 win over the Sun Kings; Ken & Barb's Restaurant beat the Englewood Moose Lodge 18 to 14 despite a homerun from Brian Donehue of the Moose; The Shipwreck Pub beat New Faull Inn 16 to 6 with Todd Widrick hitting two homeruns for Shipwreck, his 11th and 12th of the year, while the End Zone Sports Bar edged Key Agency 9 to 6.

The races in the Gold and Silver divisions are tight, with the Hitmen and New Faull Inn both at 12 wins and 4 losses; In the Silver division, Warrior Homes and Xpertech Auto Repair sit at 11 and 5, with Caddy Carts at 10 and 5 with a make up game yet to play. We could have a three way race in Silver for the first time in several years. The Elders currently lead the Bronze division, but the Bronzies still have 7 games left so things could really shift around in that division.
