Week two of the Englewood Mens' Senior Softball league saw all three divisions at play with strong performances across the board. It was a busy week, so let's get right to the scores.

The Bronze division started play on Tuesday the 17th with the Relics upending the Legends 20 to 17, while the Classics topped the Elders 16 to 12. In their Thursday games, the Legends topped the Elders 17 to 7, while the Relics beat the Classics 12 to 8.

Also on Tuesday over in the Silver division, Libee's beat Designer Tee's 19 to 11; Xpertech Auto Repair edged the Englewood Elks 19 to 18; Caddy Carts beat the Purple Panthers 22 to 14 while Artur's beat the Riverwood Relics 23 to 15.

On Thursday in the Silver division, every game was a one run game as the Englewood Elks beat the Riverwood Relics 10 to 9; Libee's edged Xpertech Auto Repair 19 to 18; the Purple Panthers topped Designer Tee's by the same score, 19 to 18 with Arturs beating Caddy Carts 15 to 14. Wow, those must have been some great games to watch with all those close scores.

Wednesday saw the Gold division get their second week off to a good start, with the Hitmen topping Scott's / Ken & Barb's Restaurant 17 to 14; the End Zone squeaked by Premier Tee's / Gulf Coast Moose 16 to 15 despite a homerun from Steve Ogin, while Key Agency, behind a home run from Jeff Clark, beat the Shipwreck Pub 25 to 15. In the clash between New Faull Inn and the Englewood Moose, the Moose held on to win 15 to 13 despite a 6 run seventh inning rally by NFI, with the Moose getting early game homeruns from Brian Donehue and Mike Vaught.

In Friday's Gold division games, Key Agency beat the End Zone 8 to 5 in a defensive battle, the Englewood Moose Lodge 1933 beat Scott's / Ken & Barb's 13 to 8; New Faull Inn sank the Shipwreck Pub 12 to 1, while Premier Tee's / Gulf Coast Moose edged the Hitmen in a 16 to 15 squeaker.

It's early in the season and as these scores suggest the play is already very strong with some great defensive work by all teams in both divisions. The fan turnout has been strong, with some terrific razzing of the umpires, all in good fun.

This week sees a full slate of games every day, with January 13th's Gold division rainout games being played this morning.
