The Englewood Senior Softball league continues to roll along this season with week four in the books. It was a busy week with the supplemental draft, make up games and a full slate of games on the schedule. In the supplemental draft tryouts held last Monday, 8 players were drafted across all the divisions and started play with their new teams. And there were three make up games in the Gold division last Monday as well, so let's get right to the scores.

On Tuesday in the Bronze division, the Elders squeaked by the Legends 17 to 16 while the Relics doubled up the Classics 12 to 6. In Thursday's Bronze games, the Relics beat the Elders 17 to 11 while the Legends topped the Classics 11 to 6.

Also on Tuesday in the Silver division, Artur's Restaurant edged Libee's Sports Bar 13 to 12; Caddy Carts rolled by Designer Tee's 23 to 7; the Purple Panthers took a bite out of the Englewood Elks 14 to 13 while Expertech Auto Repair crunched the Riverwood Relics 22 to 8.

In Thursday's Silver games, Caddy Carts edged Xpertech Auto Repair 12 to 10; the Purple Panthers crushed the Riverwood Relics 19 to 4; Artur's Restaurant beat Designer Tee's 19 to 10 while the Englewood Elks squeaked by Libee's 18 to 17.

Over in the Gold division, it was a busy week with make up games on Monday to go with regular scheduled games on Wednesday and Friday.

In Monday's games, New Faull Inn - great pizza by the way - edged the End Zone with a two run, bottom of the seventh rally, 15 to 14. The Hitmen grounded the Shipwreck Pub 15 to 12 while the Englewood Moose Lodge number 1933 beat Key Agency 17 to 5, behind Mike Vaught's third home run of the season.

On Wednesday, Scott's - Ken & Barb's trimmed Key Agency 12 to 11, the End Zone topped the Hitmen 17 to 11, Premier Tee's Gulf Coast Moose cooked New Faull Inn 22 to 10 while the Englewood Moose Lodge beat the Shipwreck Pub 18 to 7 behind home runs from Mike Vaught and Brian Donehue.

On Friday, in a well played game, Scott's / Ken & Barb's restaurant edged the Shipwreck Pub 15 to 14 behind a home run from Steve 'Barnie' Barnstead, his second of the year; the Hitmen put on an offensive show, topping New Faull Inn 23 to 10 getting runs off of three different New Faull pitchers; Key Agency got back in the win column after dropping three straight, beating Premier Tee's - Gulf Coast Moose 19 to 9; the Englewood Moose Lodge suffered their first loss of the season, the End Zone pulling off what many considered a major upset, doubling up the Moose 14 to 7, despite Brian Donehue hitting another homer for the Moose....Donehue leads the league in homers with 5.

Hard to believe but the season hits the half way point this week, with games on tap for all the teams. There's been terrific play so far with great fan turnout, so come on out and watch the action. Games are played at the Englewood Sports Complex, Tuesday thru Friday on the Adult softball fields 1 & 2 for Gold and Silver divisions, and Tuesday's and Thursday's on Little League field 7 for the Bronze division.
