Week 5 of the Englewood Senior Softball League is in the books as the half way point of the season is here. Man, the time is flying along and the games continue to get better and better. Let's get to the results from last week.

On Tuesday in the Bronze division, the Legends edged the Relics 19 to 18 while the Classics topped the Elders 17 to 10. In Thursday's Bronze action, the Relics edged the Classics 21 to 20 while the Legends topped the Elders 26 to 17. The Relics lead the Bronze division at the midpoint with a 6 & 2 record, with the Legends only one game behind at 5 & 3.

On Tuesday in the Silver division, Designer Tee's pounded the Riverwood Relics 22 to 10, the Englewood Elks gored Artur's restaurant 26 to 5; the Purple Panthers crunched Xpertech Auto Repair 20 to 9 while Caddy Carts beat Libee's Sports Bar 17 to 12.

In Thursday's Silver games, Artur's Restaurant beat the Riverwood Relics 17 to 15; Caddy Carts edged the Purple Panthers in a slugfest 24 to 23; Xpertech Auto Repair squeaked by the Englewood Elks 13 to 11 while Libee's Sports Bar beat Designer Tee's 20 to 6. At the halfway point, Caddy Carts are in first place with an 8 & 2 record, with Artur's only 1 game behind at 7 & 3. Artur's and Caddy Cards square off tomorrow at 11:00 on Field 2. Should be a good game.

On Wednesday over in the Gold division, Scott's Lawns - Ken & Barbs Restaurant edged Premier Tee's - Gulf Coast Moose 17 to 15; the Hitmen beat the Shipwreck Pub 17 to 14; New Faull Inn came from behind with 7 runs in the top of the 7th to beat the End Zone 15 to 12; while the Englewood Moose Lodge beat Key Agency 11 to 8 behind Brian Donehue's sixth homerun of the season.

In Friday's games, Scott's Lawns - Ken & Barb's Restaurant beat the Hitmen 14 to 9; the End Zone took down Premier Tee's - Gulf Coast Moose 29 to 18 behind a long homerun from Steve DeRizzo (duh-rizzo), his first of the season. The Shipwreck Pub beat Key Agency 18 to 13, while the Englewood Moose beat New Faull Inn 21 to 10, with Mike Vaught launching a rocket homerun that banged a third of the way up the light pole in left center, and Brian Donehue hitting two homeruns to deep left center to lead the Moose. Donehue now has 8 homers for the season with Vaught close behind with 5.

At the halfway point, the Englewood Moose lead the Gold division with a 9 & 1 record, followed by 5 teams at 5 & 5.

Hard to believe the season is one game shy of being half over already, but the action continues to be strong with many games being decided in the late innings in all three divisions and more homeruns than in any other year. 12 players have hit homeruns this year. Wow! The fan base continues to grow, so grab a cup of coffee and come on out and join the fun. Games are played at the Englewood Sports Complex at 0930 and 11 AM Tuesday thru Friday.
